


ABOUT ABMA



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ABOUT THE COURSE:

The comprehensive Advanced Certificate and Diploma in Monitoring and Evaluation courses are designed to equip learners with essential knowledge and practical skills to effectively assess and enhance program performance.

COURSE STRUCTURE

The Advanced Certificate Program, consisting of 31 credits in four (4) modules, plus a capstone project, covers a wide range of topics from the foundational aspects of M&E to the application of advanced techniques that can be applied in the workplace, and culminates with a capstone project.

The Diploma Program, consists of 46 credits in seven (7) modules. This includes the four (4) modules in the Advanced Certificate program, two (2) additional modules that focus on conducting effective impact and tracer studies and a substantial practical monitoring and evaluation capstone project through which learners will demonstrate their ability to apply their learning to real world problems.

FOR WHOM ARE THE COURSES DESIGNED?

These courses are designed for members of government and non-government agencies who are directly involved in Monitoring and Evaluation work. These courses are also ideal for persons who would like to develop a robust set of Monitoring and Evaluation skills.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The standard entry requirements for the Advanced Certificate and the Diploma programs are as follows:

- Three (3) subjects at CSEC, IGCSE or equivalent, inclusive of Mathematics
- Must be computer literate.
- 2 years' work experience in a related field
- Mature students 21 year and over
- ABMA Advanced Certificate in Monitoring and Evaluation (for entry into the Diploma program)

COST

15 Weeks (4 hours per week)

DIPLOMA

(6 MODULES PLUS CAPSTONE PROJECT)

DURATION:

28 Weeks (4 hours per week)

COST:

Registration Fee: \$10,000 Course Fee: \$260.000

If the student decides to pursue the Advanced Certificate first and then chooses at a later date to do the Diploma, this will take 13 weeks to complete the 2 additional modules and the Diploma will cost \$154,000 (\$4000 registration fee and \$150,000 course fee)
